National Truth and Reconciliation Day - September 30, 2024 Orange shirt day, was held to honour and remember the children who were lost in the residential school system and its survivors. It was held in front of the plaque of the Unborn at St. Joseph's Church, Highland Creek with the parishioners and friends (around 45 in attendance) led by the CWL of St. Joseph Highland Creek members as well as Fr Francis Folleh and Fr. Arinze Onwuzulike. The land acknowledgement was read, prayer service and an Indigenous song was sung "Oh Great Spirit". It was a moving experience for those in attendance.



Council: St. Aidan

In Canada, September 30 marks the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day. The day honours the children who never returned home, survivors of residential schools, their families and communities. The Catholic Women's League of St. Aidan council, during our September 26 General Meeting, observed this day by viewing a short clip on the story of Phyllis Webstad, and how she was denied wearing her orange shirt on the day she was taken from home to live in one of the residential schools. Members of CWL also wore orange shirts during the meeting to show our solidarity in raising awareness about the intergenerational impacts of residential schools and promote the message that "Every Child Matters".
