Nominations are now being accepted for the 2025 Patricia Beattie Annual Memorial Mentoring Award. We ask you to nominate that special woman who shares, nurtures, encourages growth and renewal, and responds to the needs of others. While a member's contribution to the parish and her community are most admirable, this Award is for mentoring within the CWL. Special note should be made of the nominee's support and encouragement of others to move into executive positions and/or to progress to other challenging positions beyond.

"Mentoring in the League can be defined as the process wherein one member is a pilgrim companion to the other in their journey with the Lord. It is discipleship; a dynamic relationship in which one member enables another to maximize the grace of God in her life, to become Christlike, a servant and a steward. <u>Category A - Parish Level</u>: All members at the parish council who meet the Patricia Beattie Annual Memorial Mentoring Award criteria are eligible for the Parish Level of the Award.

<u>Category B - Auxiliary Level:</u> Members who served at the regional, diocesan, provincial or national levels of the League who meet the Patricia Beattie Annual Memorial Mentoring Award criteria are eligible for the Auxiliary Level of the Award.

<u>Please Note:</u> Members of the current Toronto Diocesan Council Executive, Regional Chairs, Newsletter Editor, Convention Committee, Life Members, Past President/Historian or Patricia Beattie Annual Memorial Mentoring Award Committee are not eligible to be nominated or to nominate others. They are still able to provide suggestions on members eligible for the award.

Your submission for 2025 must be submitted to Sue Lubowitz, Past President (jslubowitz@gmail.com) by March 15, 2025. The committee will review the submissions and the recipients will be presented with their awards at the 2025 Toronto Diocesan Convention to be held April 28 and 29, 2025 at the Ajax Convention Centre.
